## PASTORAL SCHEME

This Scheme is made by the Church Commissioners (“the Commissioners”) this day of *March* ~~2010~~ <sup>10<sup>th</sup></sup> in pursuance of the Pastoral Measure 1983 (“the 1983 Measure”), the Right Reverend David, Bishop of Salisbury, having consented thereto.

### **Union of benefices and alteration of parish name**

1. The benefice of Bradford on Avon (Holy Trinity) and the benefice of Westwood and Wingfield in the diocese of Salisbury shall be united to create a new benefice which shall be named "The Benefice of Bradford on Avon Holy Trinity, Westwood and Wingfield", and the area of the new benefice shall comprise the parish of Holy Trinity, Bradford-on-Avon (the name of which shall be altered to “The Parish of Bradford on Avon Holy Trinity”), the parish of Westwood and the parish of Wingfield, which parishes shall continue distinct.

### **Archdeaconry and deanery**

2. The new benefice and its constituent parishes shall belong to the archdeaconry of Wilts and the deanery of Bradford.

### **Selection of first incumbent**

3. The first incumbent of the new benefice may be selected by the Bishop of Salisbury after consultation with the patrons of the new benefice and the parochial church councils of the parishes in the area of the new benefice.

### **Place of residence**

4. The parsonage house of the benefice of Bradford on Avon (Holy Trinity) shall be the place of residence of the incumbent of the new benefice.

### **Disposal of parsonage house**

5. The parsonage house of the benefice of Westwood and Wingfield (known as The Rectory, Westwood, Bradford-on-Avon, BA15 2AF), together with the site and appurtenances thereof and the grounds usually occupied and enjoyed therewith, shall without any conveyance or other assurance be transferred to the Salisbury Diocesan Board of Finance for disposal in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 9 of Schedule 3 to the Pastoral Measure 1983.

### **Patronage**

6. Subject to clause 3 hereof, the right of presentation to the new benefice shall on each occasion be exercised jointly by the Bishop of Salisbury in his corporate capacity; the corporate body established for the Cathedral Church of the Blessed Virgin Mary of Salisbury; the corporate body established for the Cathedral Church of the Holy and Undivided Trinity in Bristol; and the Church Pastoral Aid Society Patronage Trust, whose registered office is at Athena Drive, Tachbrook Park, Warwick, CV34 6NG.

**Amendment of group ministry**

7. Clause 1 of a Scheme made in pursuance of the Pastoral Measure 1968 by the Commissioners on the 3rd day of July 1975 providing for the establishment of a group ministry for certain benefices, as amended by two Schemes made by the Commissioners on the 10th day of May 1983 and the 11th day of May 1984 respectively in pursuance of the 1983 Measure, shall be deleted and the following shall be substituted:


‘1. A group ministry shall be established for the benefices of Bradford on Avon Holy Trinity, Westwood and Wingfield; Bradford on Avon, Christ Church; and Monkton Farleigh, South Wraxhall and Winsley, all in the diocese of Salisbury.’

**Coming into operation of this Scheme**

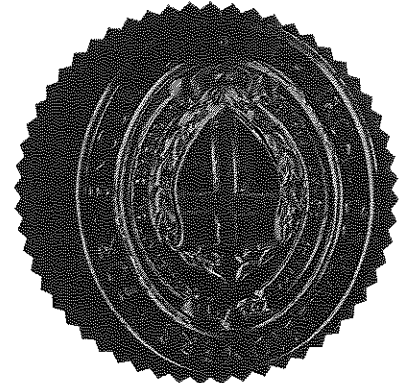
8. If upon the date the Commissioners make this Scheme the benefice of Westwood and Wingfield is vacant, this Scheme shall come into operation upon the first day of the month following the said date; but if the said benefice is then full this Scheme shall come into operation upon the date on which the said benefice is vacated.
